



## Announcement of Matthayom Wat Nongkhaem School

### Subject: No Gift Policy

In accordance with the resolution of the Cabinet dated 8 December 2020, which approved the National Reform Plan on the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (Revised Edition), it has been stipulated that key reform activities (Big Rock) shall be implemented. Under Reform Activity 4: Development of a Transparent and Conflict-of-Interest-Free Thai Bureaucracy, Goal 1, Clause 1.1, all government agencies are to declare themselves as agencies where government officials shall not accept any gifts or souvenirs in any form arising from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).

In this regard, to drive forward the aforementioned national reform plan, to enhance transparency within the organization, and to foster values and integrity within the operations of Matthayom Wat Nongkhaem School, the school hereby announces a policy that all teachers and educational personnel shall not accept any gifts or souvenirs in any form arising from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy) during all festive seasons and on any special occasions. Exceptions shall be made only in cases of necessity where avoidance is impracticable, in which case the acceptance of gifts, souvenirs, and any other benefits shall strictly comply with the criteria under the Regulations of the Office of the Prime Minister on Giving or Receiving Gifts by Government Officials, B.E. 2544 (2001), in conjunction with the Announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the Criteria for the Acceptance of Assets or Other Benefits by Government Officials in accordance with Virtue and Ethics, B.E. 2563 (2020).
